

The Annual Jacqueline Green Memorial Scholarship Application is now available from any member of the College Care & Armed Forces Committee and the Church Office. In order for you to be eligible, you must be a College Undergraduate Student for the 2015-2016 & 2016-2017 school years, and you must be an active member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church within the last five years. Application must be returned by Sunday, May 15, 2016.
